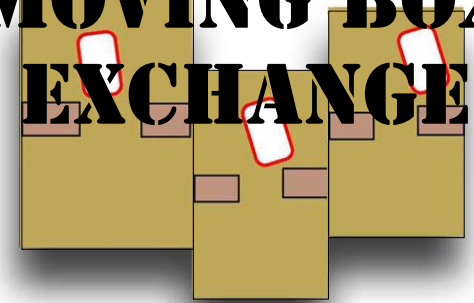

Management, Inc. to provide TWO
moving box exchange sheds that are
free and easy to use!*

*Visit the Transfer Station or
Curbside Management
to drop off or pick up used
moving boxes for free!*



HERE ARE THE DETAILS

- **Moving Boxes Only - No Liquor, Food or Other Miscellaneous Boxes**
- **Boxes Must Be Collapsed, Clean and In Good Condition**
- **Place Flattened Boxes in Size-Appropriate Bins**
- **Availability is First-Come, First-Served**

At the Transfer Station:

Check in at the scale house before proceeding to the box storage.

At Curbside Management:

Box Exchange is available during business hours when the fence gates are open.

Take Exit 1B (Brevard Road/Highway 191), at the traffic light take Highway 191 North, turn Left onto Shelburne Road, turn Left onto Hominy Creek Road, the Transfer Station will be on the Left.

From I-40

Take Exit 47 (Brevard Road/Highway 191), at the traffic light take Highway 191 North, turn Left onto Shelburne Road, turn Left onto Hominy Creek Road, the Transfer Station will be on the Left.

From Asheville on 19/23 North

Take the Woodfin/Elk Mountain Rd. Exit 24, Turn Right onto Elk Mountain Rd., Take an immediate Left onto North Woodfin Ave., Curbside is about 1/2 mile on the Left.

From North:

Take US 19/23 south. Merge onto US 25 via exit 23 North Asheville/Merrimon Ave., Turn Right (south) onto US 25/Merrimon Ave. for 0.3 miles, Turn Right on North Woodfin Ave., Curbside is 0.1 miles on the Right.

From Asheville on Merrimon Ave.

Go North on Merrimon past Beaver Lake. Go past the light and take the first Left onto North Woodfin Ave., Curbside is about 0.1 miles on the Right.
